Distribution of Outreach Funds: St. Christopher's is very fortunate to have a designated endowment fund for the purpose of outreach donations to non-profit organizations in the community. These funds are separate from any monies raised by pledges or other income to the church and allows St. C's to support non-profit groups in the community that have the goal of assisting those who are in need of a helping hand.

Each year the congregation is asked to nominate organizations that they feel would benefit from an outreach donation. The Outreach committee meets and designates recipients based on congregational requests, past history, need, and organizational goals. Recipients in 2017 included: Aloha Council of Boy Scouts, Aloha Harvest, Boys and Girls Club of Hawaii, Episcopal Relief & Development, Family Promise, Hale Kipa, IHS, International Dyslexia Association, Pu'a Foundation, and the Windward Spouse Abuse Shelter. Last year, these donations totaled over \$7,000.


