Vestry Highlights: highlighting what happened at the March meeting -

1. We approved the choices the outreach committee made of organizations to sponsor, giving a total of \$7,000.
2. We also approved moving some funds in the general endowment interest fund to other funds, including: \$12,000 into capital improvement fund; \$5,000 into Technical/Equipment Fund; \$1,500 into Angel Fund; \$1,000 into Family Promise Fund; and \$300 into Godly Play Fund. We are blessed to be able to do this!
3. St. C's pledgers are doing well and our financial pages look good.
4. Jr. Warden Paula Sterling is helping us revitalize our Congregational Care Team. If you know of someone who could use an occasional meal, or ride to the doctor, or perhaps a visit, please let the office know and we'll get the information to the team.
5. Be looking for a new front yard sign, vinyl fence behind the church, and a new storage space for our battery for our solar!
