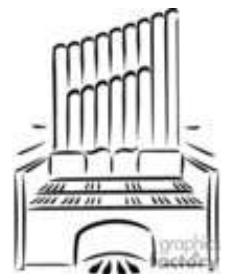
Children's activity bags are in the back of the church.
